#### STATEMENT FOR THE RECORD

Last Barrington Township Board meeting, January 15, 2025. My colleague, Trustee Edgar Alvarado read into the record that Township Supervisor Bob Alberding and Township Trustee Dan LeTourneau had been nominated in the Democratic caucus on December 3, 2024; to serve as Township Supervisor and Township Trustee in the Consolidated Election on April 1,2025. The only objection was that these two gentlemen were not qualified as candidates, only because they were Republicans and now are representing Democrats. Mr. Alberding and Mr. LeTourneau, who have served their terms on the Barrington Township Board and are residents of the Township; want to keep giving something back to their community of Barrington Township by running for Supervisor and Trustee again.

Furthermore, Barrington Township Republican Committeeman / Party Chairman, Peter Kopsaftis who is the objector to Mr. Alberding and Mr. LeTourneau; did not ask these two gentlemen if they were interested in running in the Republican caucus. At the Republican caucus, a group to fill the four Trustee's spots and Supervisor's spot were nominated. Furthermore, Mr. Kopsaftis as the objector-petitioner brought his petition against Mr. Alberding and Mr. LeTourneau to the Township Officers Electoral Board of Barrington Township Cook County, Illinois on January 15. 2025 at 2:00 PM. All parties presented their case and after hearing those arguments the Electoral Board of Barrington Township made their findings that the nomination papers of Bob Alberding and Dan LeTourneau are valid and their names shall appear on the April 1,2025 Consolidated Election Ballot. Election Board Members being; Edgar Alvarado, Trustee/ Chairman, Fritz Gohl, Trustee and Hon. Judge Mathias Delort, (Ret). The ruling was (two) in favor and (one) against the Respondents nomination papers being valid.
