- A. Finance - Trustee Deering: No Report
- B. Community Relations - Trustee Deligio: Gave a verbal report on the following: Trustee Deligio reported that ADA requirements were updated and that the deadline for website compliance is April 2028. He also stated that he is compiling additional vendor options, with an emphasis on services, marketing, and social media. The Board discussed the vendor Constant Contact, and Trustee Deligio noted both its potential use and its limitations. Trustee Deering expressed support for reviving the Township newsletter. It was agreed that the Administrator would forward the previously used newsletter template to Trustee Deering.
- C. Cemetery/Planning/Operations - Trustee Langan provided a written report to the board. He noted that signage needs to be replaced and will ask the board during new business to support the spending of signage replacement.
- D. Legislative/Policy/Contracts/Risk Management – Trustee LeTourneau gave a verbal report on the following: The awarded contractor bid packet was reviewed prior to the Board meeting, and all risk management and insurance requirements were found to be satisfactory. The matter is now ready to proceed under Old Business with the award to Peter Baker and Son Co.
