SAY:

Today, we're looking at the life of Elijah in the Bible! Elijah had won a significant spiritual battle. He had defeated the prophets of Baal and proved that our God was the REAL God. It was a definite "high" moment in his life!

After a really CRAZY-long run where he ran faster than a chariot, Elijah found himself feeling very weak - both physically and emotionally. So he drifted into a deep sleep. Then, Elijah was visited by an angel who gave him food to eat. Elijah was strengthened in a big way during one of the weakest and lowest points of his life.

READ:

1 Kings 18:41 - 19:9

ASK/DISCUSS:

- What was the name of the prophet in our Bible Story today?
- What did Elijah say about to come to the land of Israel?
- What did Elijah outrun?
- What did Queen Jezebel promise to do to Elijah?
- What did Elijah tell God he was ready to do?
- Then what happened?

SAY:

When we are weak, God is strong. If we call on Him, He will give us the strength we need to overcome our own weakness!

PRAY:

Pray for God to fill your children with His strength. Pray for God to help them make it on the journey that He has for them.
