READ:

2 Kings 5

ASK/DISCUSS:

- What was the name of the army officer in today's Bible Story?
- What disease did Naaman suffer from?
- How many times did Elisha say to dip in the Jordan River?
- What happened when Naaman came up from the river the seventh time?

SAY:

Naaman was told to do some very odd things in order to receive his healing. Elisha knew that Naaman had a problem trusting and obeying. If he didn't follow God's instructions, God was not going to heal him.

When God speaks, we should obey. It doesn't matter if what He says makes sense to us. We are to obey simply because we are His children and He is our Heavenly Father.

If we will obey no matter what, we will find ourselves in the same spot that Naaman found himself - on the other side of his miracle. God is not asking us to "earn" His power. He is asking us to trust Him and obey Him.
