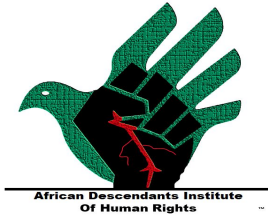

Afro-Descendant Nation Confederated USA

RE: Notices of Nation and Accessions to Conventions, Treaty and International Law

Dear UN Secretary-General

Please accept these presentations from the Afro-Descendant Nation Confederated AKA African Descendant Nation on behalf of its nation of 5,000 plus Afro-descendant Americans and the 45 million colonized Afro-descendants who have not had the opportunity to determine their status.

On October 1, 2017, fifty-Six 56 Africans Descendants in the United States of America signed a Declaration of Self Determination. Currently, we number over 5,000 citizens with open citizenship to 45 Million Afro-Descendants. We are informed by two polls conducted by IHRAAM the International Human Rights Association of American Minorities who has Consultative Status with the UN Human Rights Commission was informed that 77% and 82% of Afro-descendants would choose Self-determination.

Thereafter, on, September 24, 2018, the African Descendant Nation filed a “Request to be placed on the Decolonization List in the United Nations Decolonization Committee and Presented a Prima Facie case pursuant to 1541 Principles which Should guide Members in determining whether or not an obligation exists to transmit the information called for under Art 73 e of the Charter.”¹

Afro-Descendant Nation Confederated USA has citizens in over 20 states of the United States and we feel compelled to assert or right to be recognized as an emerging state². The Afro-

- Article XIII of the International Convention of the Suppression and Punishment of the Crime of Apartheid, Article 67 of the UN Convention against Corruption,
- Convention on the Elimination of Racism
- Article 43 of the Convention on the Right of Persons with Disability. By Article 62, respectively 61,141, and 157 of the Four Conventions; the accession of the Confederated Nation-state took effect October 1, 2017.

The U.S. Afro-Descendant Confederated Nation-state also affirms its obligation to abide by the UN Charter, OAS Charter, A U Charter, OAU Charter, whereby the coordination of U.S. African Descendant states with each other shall be strengthened. The Confederated Nation-state calls upon U.S. Afro- Descendants to assert their democratic right by more Plebiscites until we can nationally merge and enhance the emergence of our State, to mobilize potential, and to intensify efforts whose goal is to end U.S. subjugation, state terrorism, apartheid, colonialism, and occupation.

Herein, the Confederation declares it will settle domestic, regional, and international disputes by peaceful means by the UN Charter and resolutions. Without prejudice to the natural right to defend its right to self-governance, self-recognition, territorial integrity, and independence. Members of the Confederation rejects the threat or use of force, terrorism, and violence against its political independence, or territorial integrity. The Confederated Nation-state intends to safeguards the citizens of the Confederations cultural, political, economic, religious integrity through a parliamentary democratic system of governance.
