***USPIE* recognizes the recipient of May's 'Millstone of the Month' award: Nicole Hannah-Jones for the 1619 Project**

*'The Millstone of the Month Award': the award you never want

COLUMBIA, S. C. — *United States Parents Involved in Education's* ([**USPIE**](#)) announces that the "[**Millstone of the Month Award**](#)" for May goes to Hannah Nicole-Jones, the author of the 1619 Project. The Millstone of the Month is a monthly recognition of an individual who is actively working to deceive, indoctrinate, or negatively impact children with leftist, anti-God propaganda. The name of the award is taken from Matthew 18:6, which says "Whoever causes one of these little ones who believes in me to sin, it would be better for him to have a great millstone fastened around his neck and to be drowned in the depth of the sea."

The 1619 Project, a work of [**race Marxism**](#) sneaking more CRT into classrooms, was written with a few cherry-picked items spun into a [**make-believe origin story**](#) of the founding of the United States. Critics on the left and right [**have excoriated the work**](#) for presenting an utterly false representation of the founding of the country. Not only is the scurrilous 1619 Project in local schools; this reprehensible rewrite of US history is now even [**offered on HULU**](#) to spread lies about America. Jones, the author of these falsehoods, is appropriately recognized with this month's Millstone of the Month for actively promulgating this evil rubbish.

USPIE is first and foremost for parents’ rights, and we support our parents who stand against school boards and teachers who object to the kind of falsehoods the 1619 Project pushes on young impressionable children.
