## USPIE awards North Dakota Superintendent Dr. Rupak Gandhi with May's Millstone of the Month

'The Millstone of the Month Award' is given to individuals actively working to negatively harm children with woke propaganda

**COLUMBIA, S. C.** — *United States Parents Involved in Education's* (<u>USPIE</u>) announces that the "<u>Millstone of the Month Award</u>" for May goes to North Dakota's Fargo Public Schools Superintendent <u>Dr. Rupak Gandhi</u> for bypassing state law prohibiting schools from keeping families in the dark about students' gender identities. "We will not openly out any student because of one law if we know that that's going to cause harm to that child," Dr. Gandhi said recently, causing many parents to realize the tragic truth — America's government education system is actively looking to undermine and remove parents from the lives of their own children.

"This month's Millstone Award recipient is well-deserved," said USPIE Founder and President Sheri Few. "Dr. Gandhi clearly believes that he knows these children better than their parents. Government schools have been trying to oust parents out of their own child's education for years, but this superintendent is openly flouting the law in his quest for a 'woke' badge of honor. What sort of precedent is he setting for the children in the district he represents — that the law can be disregarded on a whim? The law is the law for a reason, and it is not up to individuals to pick and choose what they will follow.
