Benefits of the annual \$10.00 membership in HOAGBA:

- The 8-page newsletter "Heartland News" is mailed out 6 times a year (January-February, March-April, May-June, July-August, September-October, & November-December). Almost every issue also includes a color photo insert.
- Not only does the newsletter list swaps and auctions and birds and animals for sale, but it also contains feature articles, helpful hints, and other information pertinent to people interested in birds and animals. Belonging to an association is a way for you to network and keep in touch with other people with similar interests and concerns.
- Members may run free ads of up to 50 words in each issue if they choose to do so. Ads also appear on the web site on the Newsroom page.
- As a member you can be listed in the Membership Directory which is revised every 2 years.
- Your membership also entitles you to sell for 15 % commission at the club auctions.
