## **Frequently Asked Questions:**

CAN I HAVE A YARD/GARAGE TYPE SALE?

No commercial establishments of any nature shall be permitted on any lot in the Addition.

#### **Mail Boxes:**

Mailboxes are the sole responsibility of the homeowner. As your mailboxes begin to weather please apply new stain to the mail boxes. See below, we've included a drawing that shows information about the construction of the mail boxes as well as the stain color and type of stains to be used.

**Address Number:** 4" <u>brass</u> numbers, on one or both sides, located as indicated.

**Approved Colors:** Olympic brand "Olympic Solid Stains"

Color #1 - "Russet" Color #2 – "Beige Gray"
