The city's only responsibility is to replace it with a standard metal stop sign. The wood framed signs are another feature that helps make Wildwood unique from other QC Neighborhoods.

<u>Association Tax Preparation</u> - As a non-profit organization, it is our responsibility to maintain our corporate status, including paying the required taxes.
