

Reflection for the Third Sunday of Ordinary Time

From that time on, Jesus began to preach and say, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand," Mt. 4:17.

Beginning this Sunday, the *Gospel According to Saint Matthew* is proclaimed at all the Sunday Masses of Ordinary Time. To get more out of our participation at Mass when we hear this Gospel proclaimed, it is helpful to know something about its structure and message.

The position of the Gospel According to Saint Matthew as the first of the four gospels in the New Testament reflects the view of the early Church that it was the first to be written and the esteem in which it was held by the Church. Because of its rich theological content, Matthew was used as the primary catechetical text in the early Church and was the Gospel most quoted by the Fathers of the Church. It is the longest of the four Gospels and consists of twenty-eight chapters. This Gospel is distinctive for its practice of citing the Old Testament in connection with Jesus' activity and teaching. We have an example of this in today's gospel passage: "He left Nazareth and went to live in Capernaum by the sea, in the region of Zebulun and Naphtali, that what had been said through Isaiah the prophet might be fulfilled: Land of Zebulun and land of Naphtali..." Mt. 4:13-16. Another important feature of the Gospel of Matthew is its structured presentation of Jesus' doctrine in the form of sermons or discourses. There are five: the sermon on the mount in chapters 5-7; the instructions to his apostles whom he sends on mission in chapter 10; the mystery of the reign of God revealed in parables in chapter 13; the Christian community and the Church in chapter 18; the teaching on the coming kingdom in chapter 24-24.

These five great discourses of Jesus in the Gospel of Matthew would have made a devout Jew think of the Torah, that is, the first five books of the Bible: Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, and Deuteronomy. Matthew portrays Jesus as the new Moses who will lead his redeemed people from the slavery of sin to the promised land beyond this world. In fact, the Jews believed that a prophet like Moses would be sent by God: "I will raise up for them a prophet like you (Moses) from among their fellow Israelites, and I will put my words in his mouth. He will tell them everything I command him," cf. Dt. 18:18.

The Gospel of Matthew is about fulfillment because it shows that Jesus of Nazareth was the Messiah foretold by the prophets, the Son of God. It presents Jesus as the new Moses who establishes the new covenant not with the blood of bulls and goats, but with his own blood. "For amen I say unto you, till heaven and earth pass, one jot, or one tittle shall not pass of the law, till all be fulfilled," Mt. 5:18.

The opening chapter of Matthew tells of a messiah who will be called "Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins" and also be called "Immanuel, which means God with us." Matthew most emphatically stresses the continued presence of Jesus throughout his ministry and with his disciples after Easter. In the middle of the Gospel of Matthew Jesus says: "Where two or three are gathered in my name there I am in their midst," Mt. 18:18.

The entire gospel narrative ends with Jesus-Immanuel standing in the presence of his disciples and saying to them "I am with you always," Mt. 28:20. Indeed, he is- in the Most Blessed Sacrament of the Eucharist. Come, let us adore Him.


