


SANTA CRUZ ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH DISCALCED CARMELITE FRIARS





MISSION SUNDAY-OCTOBER 24th, 2021

Each year the Church presents us with a special weekend dedicated to the consideration of the Missions of the Church, inviting us to learn more about them and support them generously with our prayers, sacrifices, and financial support. These are usually referred to as the "Foreign Missions" in another country poorer than our own. For the last 25 or more years, I have had the privilege of serving on the mission in Kenya and Uganda as a missionary and of promoting our own missionary efforts here in the United States. Now in my later years I am happy to write about them in book form, "African Memories", hopefully soon to be published.

The Church is "missionary" by its very nature and is based on the final command of Jesus in the last words of Matthew's Gospel, "Go therefore, make disciples of all nations, baptizing them teaching themand know that I am with you all days until the end of time". We are reminded of this commissioning at the end of each Mass when the priest dismisses us with the words "Go in peace to love and serve the Lord".

We have many great missionary saints in the Church like John de Brebeuf and Isaac Jogues in our own land, Francis Xavier in India and the far East. As well, we have St Therese of Lisieux, a Carmelite contemplative nun, who has been appointed Patroness of the Missions with the great Francis Xavier. Her short life is well known and even though she was an enclosed contemplative, who died of T.B. at the age of 24, she was truly a great missionary.

We might also look at another great contemplative, St Teresa of Avila, who can also be classified as a great missionary in her response to God's call in her life. As a little girl of approx. 8 years, she longed for heaven and convinced her brother to run away from home to preach the Gospel to the Moors, who would no doubt kill the 2 of them and they would get to heaven fast! They set out but were soon caught by their uncle and brought back home safely.


In the Augustinian high School, Teresa made friends with the nuns there but felt they were too strict for her vocation and decided to join the Carmelites, even against her father's wishes. In the Carmelite monastery she enjoyed the community, the prayers and the relaxed social contacts she could maintain. But she also shared with her friends the possibility of a more dedicated interior way of life in a new setting. This was realized in the foundation of St Joseph's monastery in Avila where they lived the reformed Carmelite life generously. There, she was very happy until a Franciscan missionary from Mexico spoke to the community about the needs of the people and the Church in his mission. Teresa was deeply moved and begged the Lord to show her how she could help. He told her "Wait a little, my daughter, and you will see great things". These "great things" were to extend the reform of the Discalced Carmelite way of life to many other places in Spain and to help in the establishment of the Order among the Friars with the help of St John of the Cross.

She was delighted when the Discalced Carmelite men took on the mission to the Congo in Africa and fully supported it. In all these achievements, Teresa met with opposition, great difficulties but she also had great faith, courage and trust in God's mercy. She was always open to God's invitations to new things in her life.

How open am I to follow the call of Jesus

"Go, make disciples of all nations", in my own family, in my own sphere of influence, in poor people longing for the truth of the Gospel and a better way of life here at home in our own country and in foreign lands ... "Lord, what do you want me to do"?
