

### Reflection for the 33<sup>rd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

At this time we are approaching the end of the Liturgical year; next Sunday, November 21<sup>st</sup>, will be the feast of Christ the King and the last Sunday of the current Liturgical year. The following Sunday, November 28<sup>th</sup> is the First Sunday of Advent and the beginning of a new year in the Liturgy.

The readings at Mass during these final days of the year focus considerably on the end of times, on the last judgement but also on the anxieties of the present age. It is not easy to separate one from another so it is no wonder that people think that the end of the world is near. Jesus links the two together

"Amen I say to you, this generation will not pass away until all these things have taken place".

This surely reminds us that each generation has its share of trials, persecutions, anxieties, and fearful happenings that can disturb us but that can also inspire us to put all our trust in the Lord Jesus, our Savior and the Savior of mankind.

Who of us does not wonder about what is happening in the Covid 19 pandemic, climate change, ongoing wars and poverty, and even our western democratic system of governing. We question all these, and as well we are often devastated by personal losses in marriage, in the priesthood, and in lives cut down by violence, drug addiction, and suicide.

Jesus too, in His Sacred Humanity knew well about injustice, abuse of power, violence, and foresaw persecution and even the destruction of the Temple in Jerusalem. How do we make sense of all these events? How did the Lord deal with them in His own life? We cannot close our eyes to them or smile our way through them. The death and Resurrection of Jesus which we celebrate at every Mass is a powerful antidote to our feelings of helplessness and towards our tendency to disassociate ourselves from reality.

The image of the fig tree in today's gospel seems, at first sight, to be out of place. It puts a happy, positive, and hopeful note on our darkest reflections and fears - "When its branch becomes tender and sprouts leaves, you know that summer is near". (Confer chapter 11 for the account of the barren fig tree and how it withered after Jesus cursed it – verses 12-14 and 20-21).

We find comfort in the words and actions of our beloved Savior, "Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away". Let us renew our faith and trust in His words that enlighten us, set us free, and nourish our hearts and lives in every age and every situation...

He is "the Way, the Truth and the Life".
