

#### The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe

"Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom," Lk. 23:42.

I always look forward to celebrating Christ the King on the last Sunday of the liturgical year and hearing our people cry, **Viva Cristo Rey**. One of my favorite hymns is *The King of Love my Shepherd Is*. The first verse is: The King of love my Shepherd is,/ Whose goodness fails me never;/ I nothing lack if I am his/ And he is mine forever. It is a lovely rendering of Psalm 23- *The Lord is my Shepherd*. I like picturing Christ as our Shepherd King of love.

Why is our beautiful King of love presented to us in today's gospel hanging on the Cross and being mocked as the King of the Jews, not even capable of saving himself? "He saved others, let him save himself if he is the chosen one, the Christ of God." On this Sunday, we contemplate Christ crucified and yet we are celebrating Him as King of the Universe. What is going on here? The thief crucified next to Christ knows what is going on when he says, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom." The Crucified One has a kingdom. St. Paul speaks of this in his Letter to the Colossians: "Let us give thanks to the Father, who has made you fit to share in the inheritance of the holy ones in light. He delivered us from the power of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of his beloved Son, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins." Thrones, dominions, principalities, and powers were all created through Jesus and for Jesus. He is before all things, and in him all things hold together. Christ, the universal King, has made peace by the blood of his cross. We also believe, as we profess in our Creed, "He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead." From the earliest times, the prospect of the Judgement has influenced Christians in their daily living as a criterion by which to order their present life, as a summons to their conscience, and at the same time as hope in God's justice. Faith in Christ has never looked merely backwards or merely upwards, but always also forwards to the hour of justice that the Lord repeatedly proclaimed. This looking ahead has given Christianity its importance for the present moment. Christ the Lord will return as a glorious king, robed in majesty. "When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, he will sit on his glorious throne," Mt. 25:31. "And will not God bring about justice for his chosen ones, who cry out to him day and night? Will he keep putting them off? I tell you, he will see that they get justice, and quickly. However, when the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on the earth?" Lk.18:7-8.

The idea of the Last Judgement is hardly conceivable to people who never think of God and are totally engrossed in this world. A world without God is a world without hope (cf. *Eph.* 2:12). Only God can create justice. And faith gives us the certainty that he does so. The image of the Last Judgement is an image of hope. But it is also an image that evokes responsibility. God is justice and creates justice. This is our consolation and our hope. And in his justice, there is also grace. This we know by turning our gaze to the crucified and risen Christ. Grace does not cancel out justice. It does not make wrong into right. It is not a sponge which wipes everything away, so that whatever someone has done on earth ends up being of equal value. If this were so, the idea of a Last Judgement would be meaningless.

Our most pressing duty as Christian is to insist on the Lordship of Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. We must witness against the idols of the world. When Christ our King returns in glory, he will judge all things and order them toward their final end. We cannot serve Our King and Mammon (Matt. 6:24). And we cannot serve our King and Progress, Utility and Science. We must serve Christ Our King with our whole heart, mind, and soul. **Viva Cristo Rey**.
