### Reflection for the 32<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time November 6th

November is the month of the Holy Souls, but it was ushered in by the Solemnity of All Saints, which in turn was preceded by Hallowe'en celebrations. A new month is always a new hope and as we pray for the Holy Souls in Purgatory our focus moves to hope that our beloved dead and all of us will share in the Resurrection of Jesus. We write the names of our dead in the Remembrance book and we visit their resting places in our cemeteries. Naturally our mind turns to the 4 last things — death, heaven, hell, and purgatory — which is not to make us morose, but to reaffirm our faith in the goodness and mercy of God and to look forward to meeting Him in heaven. It is always good for us to reflect on these events, to prepare for them as "we know not the day or the hour", and to encourage our sick or elder members of our families to prepare well for them.

Pope St. John the XXIII was noted for his good humor and simplicity of life. When afflicted with stomach cancer in his late years, he was asked by a friend how he was doing; he replied with typical faith and honesty, "My bags are packed"! Pope Francis in one of his October daily reflections (which can be found on the computer under Journey With The Pope, followed by the date) gives his usual brief message and ends up with Pope John's words. Here is the full message of Pope Francis:

"Let us ask ourselves if we, in the Church, start with God and his loving gaze upon us. We are always tempted to start from ourselves rather than from God, to put our own agenda before the Gospel, to let ourselves be caught up in the winds of worldliness sin order to chase after the fashions of the moment or turn our back on the time that Providence has granted us, in order to retrace our steps. Towards the end of his life Pope John wrote: "This life of mine, now nearing its sunset, could find no better end than in the concentration of all my thoughts on Jesus, the Son of Mary a great and constant friendship with Jesus, contemplated as a Child and upon the Cross, and adored in the Blessed Sacrament."

These words of Pope Francis are his message for October 19<sup>th</sup> of this year. His daily message is inspiring and simple, akin to the Flocknotes of our local Pastor, Fr Stephen. It is good to have some daily spiritual nourishment for our journey together in life. Have a happy November.




