John the Baptist appeared, preaching in the desert of Judea and saying, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand!"

MATTHEW 3:1

Second Sunday of Advent, December 4, 2022

The season of Advent gives us a wonderful array of biblical characters who inspire and challenge us to grow in faith. We have biblical writers such as Isaiah the prophet, St Paul and St Matthew; married couples — Mary and Joseph, and Elizabeth and Zachary; the Archangel Gabriel and a company of his fellow angels; shepherds and kings; John the Baptist and our Savior and Lord, Jesus.

In the second and third Sundays of Advent John the Baptist is highlighted. He is one who always gets our attention. No wonder Jesus referred to him "no one greater than he has been born of woman". He comes from the desert wilderness in traditional Old Testament clothing of camel skin tunic and belt: he has the austerity of one who fed on wild honey and berries. He must have had a gaunt face and eyes sharpened by fasting. He is not gentle like Jesus, nor persuasive like Paul – in fact he could be described, as we often say in Ireland, as "a holy terror". Others refer to him as "God's rottweiler". He was not a man to trifle with. Yet amazingly the crowds flocked to him from miles around to listen to his call to serious repentance and denouncing the evils of society.

He challenged the motivation of the scribes and pharisees who came from Jerusalem to hear him, "Brood of vipers, who warned you to flee from the retribution that is coming? If you are repentant, produce the appropriate fruit"! Yet when Jesus appeared before him in the river Jordan, he was surprised and confused, but Jesus insists, and the words from above, "This is my beloved son, in whom I am well pleased", were powerful and affirming for John as well as for the many others who came to be baptized by him. Later John questioned the report that Jesus was friendly with sinners and even had meals with them. Yet he knew his place and he stepped back.

"I baptize you with water for repentance, but the one who follows me is more powerful than I am, and I am not fit to carry his sandals; he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with fire".

Jesus now steps forward to center stage, while the greatest prophet that ever lived, fades into the background. John had done his work. He had convicted us of our evil; he bore witness to the Savior. We are grateful for John's startling presence in our world. But we cannot remain with John. Our religion is not a gospel of fear, but of confidence in the mercy of God. We are called to repent and to bear fruit, but above all to be merciful as our heavenly Father and His Son are merciful.

Maranatha! Come Lord Jesus! Come Holy Spirit! Come Loving Father!

Enjoy your Advent by bearing rich fruit. ~ Fr David OCD


