Sixth Sunday
IN ORDINARY TIME

Brothers and sisters, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do everything for the

GLORY OF GOD.

A leper came to Jesus and kneeling down begged him and said, "If you wish, you can make me clean." Moved with compassion, he stretched out his hand, touched him and said to him, "I do will it. Be made clean." Mark 1:40-41

Moved with compassion, Jesus touched the leper and healed him. This was probably the first time the leper had ever been touched. February 11 is World Day of the Sick. It was designated as such by St. Pope John Paul II in 1992. It is providential that it occurs on this Sunday when the Gospel proclamation is about Jesus curing the leper. Jesus relates to the leper as a human being, someone whose distressful sickness elicits his compassion and tenderness. I have often witnessed the kindness and goodness of our parishioners towards the sick, especially those elderly and infirm lovingly cared for at home. The way the leper in the Gospel story implores Jesus for a cure is remarkable for its directness. "If you so will, you can make me clean." And Jesus replies with equal directness. "I do will it. Be cleansed." The Greek verb for "You can do (it)" could be rendered, "You have the power." It is the same Greek word from which the word dynamic is derived. Jesus is dynamic. He has the power. But His power is put into motion, so to speak, by his compassion. It is important for us to realize that Jesus has shared his power with us. We are baptized into Christ and that means we share his power, his dynamism. Yes, we too can be moved by compassion and touch others with our tenderness and kindness like Jesus. Do you will it? Let our answer be, "I do will it. I have the power."

SANTA CRUZ PARISH FAMILY OF THE YEAR

Last year, to commemorate the 100th anniversary of the parish, I choice a family for special recognition as the FAMILY OF THE YEAR. The Andy and Linda Cancino family were recognized at a parish social event concluding the centenary celebration of the parish which was held on February 16, 2020. Due to the pandemic, we are not able to gather to celebrate the anniversary (birthday) of the Santa Cruz Parish. Nevertheless, I still want to recognize a family as the FAMILY OF THE YEAR. I hope this will become a tradition to be observed in conjunction with the anniversary of the parish. (The church was consecrated on February 9, the parish was canonically erected on February 12). The 2021 FAMILY OF THE YEAR is the Marco and Lourdes Leon family.

Marco and Lourdes served for four years as co-directors of Elijah's Knights, Santa Cruz Youth Group. Lourdes is also involved in music ministry and Marco serves as a lector and Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion. During this time, Marco and Lourdes also pursued adoption and adopted twins - Suzanna and Isaiah. Most parents have nine months to prepare a house for a newborn. They had only 7 days to get their house ready for the four-year-old twins.

This past year, which will always be remembered for the way our worship was affected by the pandemic, the Leon family has been a big part of the live-stream Mass every Sunday. If you have followed it at home, you know what a beautiful family they are, Dad reading at Mass and Mom singing with her daughter Suzanna, and Isaiah serving.
