#### Fifth Sunday of Easter

May is Mary's Month, and I Muse at that and wonder why: Her feasts follow reason Dated due to season –

Ask of her, the mighty mother Her reply put this other Question: What is Spring? Growth in everything –


These are the first 4 verses of Gerard Manley Hopkins' 12 verse poem "The May Magnificat", written in 1918, long before the month of May opened with the liturgical feast day of St Joseph the Worker. May and October are 2 months dedicated to Mary, but Joseph must also be remembered in this "Year of St. Joseph". Here at Santa Cruz, we honor St. Joseph every Wednesday with a Votive Mass when the liturgy allows it, and by reciting the Litany of St. Joseph at the end of our community Evening Prayer at 5 pm. Fr. Stephen is also nourishing our trust in St. Joseph with regular reflections on his life.

Mary and Joseph are at the heart of the life of Jesus and consequently at the heart of the life of the Church. Not only do we honor Mary with special devotion in this month of May but she is intimately connected to the other great feasts of the Ascension (Ascension Thursday on May 13<sup>th</sup> or Ascension Sunday on May 16<sup>th</sup>) and Pentecost Sunday (May 23<sup>rd</sup>). Mary's presence with the disciples on that first Novena between Ascension and Pentecost was a special time of encouragement for the apostles gathered in prayer and empowered by the Holy Spirit to become faithful and generous witnesses to Jesus and to His message of salvation. Furthermore, the day after Pentecost we celebrate the feast of Mary, Mother of the Church and end the month with the feast of the Blessed Trinity (May 30<sup>th</sup>).

Pope St. John Paul II expressed his devotion to Mary in choosing as his motto "Totus Tuus", which is the Latin for "totally thine", and is from the prayer of consecration to Mary given by St. Luis de Montfort in "True Devotion to Mary". The full sentence is "I belong entirely to you, and all that I have is yours", followed by "I take you for my all. O Mary, give me your heart". Whether we express our devotion to Mary, addressing her as Our Lady of Guadalupe, the Immaculate Conception, Our Lady of Knock or Our Lady of Mount Carmel, or any other appropriate title, we know how much she cares about each one of her sons and daughters and is willing to help us in every situation, big or small. She was given to us on Calvary when Jesus spoke those wonderful words from the Cross to John and consequently to each one of us, "Behold your Mother".

Let this month of May be a joyful and genuine renewal of our love for our Blessed Mother.
