Reflection for the Twenty-first Sunday in Ordinary Time

"Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe and are convinced that you are the Holy One of God." Jn. 6:69

The above verse from today's Gospel concludes our proclamation of chapter 6 of the Gospel of St. John which began five Sundays ago with the story of the miracle about the multiplication of the loaves and fishes and the feeding of 5,000 men. After we heard about this miracle on the 17th Sunday of Ordinary Time, the following Sunday Jesus began His teaching on the Bread of Life. "I am the Bread of Life," he said in verse 35. Then the next Sunday, we heard Him tell us that, "If anyone eats this bread he shall live forever; the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world," Jn. 6:51. Last Sunday was the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Virgin Mary so we did not hear the gospel proclamation of the 20th Sunday of Ordinary Time when Jesus says, "My flesh is real food and my blood real drink. The man who feeds on my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him," Jn. 6:55-56.

This Sunday's Gospel begins (Jn.6:60) with the reaction of the listeners to all that Jesus has said about the Bread of Life. "This saying is hard; who can accept it?" In response to Jesus' teaching on the Bread of Life, "many of his disciples returned to their former way of life and no longer accompanied him," Jn. 6:66. We should clearly understand that Jesus was talking about the Holy Eucharist when he spoke of feeding on His flesh and drinking His blood. It is the same body and blood He offered on the cross to the Eternal Father for the life of the world. It is the same body and blood we receive in Holy Communion which is the Eucharist.

Do we know why we go to Mass? We go to Mass to offer God the Body and Blood of His Son in the sacramental sacrifice which is at the heart of every Mass. This is why the Church teaches that the Holy Mass is the "source and summit" of our Christian life of faith. "Taking part in the Eucharistic sacrifice, which is the source and summit of the whole Christian life, they offer the Divine Victim to God, and offer themselves along with It. Thus, both by reason of the offering and through Holy Communion all take part in this liturgical service, not indeed, all in the same way but each in that way which is proper to himself." In the Blessed Eucharist is contained the whole spiritual good of the Church, namely Christ himself.

Unhappily, according to a reliable survey, only one-third of Catholics believe in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist, implying a similar lack of belief that the faithful are aware of what the Mass is, and that they are actively participating in Christ's self-offering of the sacrifice of love that is being celebrated at Mass. Some of this is the fault of priests who have not celebrated the Mass in a dignified and proper way, and who have taken unjustified liberties with the rubrics for the celebration of Mass. Whatever the reason for the lack of faith and understanding regarding Mass and the Most Holy Eucharist, we must recover its true and proper meaning if we are going to be a vibrant Christian community and zealous disciples of Christ, Our Lord, who can keep the faith in these times we are living. "When the Son of Man comes will he find faith on earth?" Lk.18:8. Our Lord warns us that because of the increase of wickedness, the love of most will grow cold, Mt. 24:12.

Besides faithfully attending Mass on Sunday, the Lord's Day, let us try to make a visit to the Blessed Sacrament at least once during the week and knell before the tabernacle and tell the Lord how grateful you are for all that He has done for you. This will please Him immensely.

And let us journey together in faith,
