


# SANTA CRUZ ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH DISCALCED CARMELITE FRIARS





#### Reflection for the 22nd Sunday of Ordinary Time

From within people, from their hearts, come evil thoughts, unchastity, theft, murder, adultery, greed, malice, deceit, licentiousness, envy, blasphemy, arrogance, folly. All these evils come from within, and they defile.

After five weeks of proclaiming the Gospel of John, chapter six, we return to the proclamation of the Gospel according to St. Mark. When we last heard St. Mark's Gospel proclaimed, Jesus was telling his disciples to come away to quiet place and rest. But the people followed them, and Jesus began to teach them. Then the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves of bread takes place, after which Jesus and the disciples return to the other side of the lake. That is when the Pharisees with some scribes who had come from Jerusalem gathered around Jesus, and they began to question him. This leads Jesus to say what is quoted above, that it is the evil that comes out of the heart that defiles a person. Thirteen forms of evil are here noticed as proceeding from the heart.

The Greek word for heart is Kardia, pronounced kar-dee'-ah. (Remember, all the New Testament was written in Greek.) The Greek word for heart is the origin of words we are familiar with- cardiologist, cardiac, and cardiogram. The Greek word kardia can also mean- mind, character, inner self, will, intention, center. It is the same in English when we use the word heart.

It is the things that come from the heart, such as wicked thoughts and affections, words and actions that defile us, not the things we eat. As a corrupt fountain sends forth corrupt streams, so does a corrupt heart send forth corrupt reasonings, corrupt appetites and passions, and all the wicked words and actions that come from them. A spiritual understanding of the law of God, and a sense of the evil of sin, will cause a person to seek for the grace of the Holy Spirit.

With the grace of the Holy Spirit, we can attain to purity of heart. This is what we should be striving for. This was the goal of those whom we venerate as saints. Not everyone can be a missionary, or teach, or preach, or heal, or raise a family. But anyone can strive for purity of heart. God looks to the heart. When Jesus praised Nathaniel he said, "Here is a true child of Israel. There is no duplicity in him." This means that Nathaniel's heart was not deceitful.

The heart, then, represents our will and desire. What does our heart want? What do we intend? Surely, we do not want the things Jesus mentions-theft, murder, adultery, etc.

We should examine our hearts intentions regularly, even daily. This is called an examination of conscience. Our conscience tells us what is in our heart. We need the help of the Holy Spirit to enlighten our conscience so we can know our own heart. We don't always know what is in our heart. We need to grow in knowledge of ourselves. This is why the saints say self-knowledge is so important. We go to a cardiologist to have our heart examined. Let us go to the Holy Spirit to have our heart's intentions examined. Then, maybe, we can walk in the truth, without, guile or deceit. This is purity of heart.

Let us journey together in faith,
