

Dear Parishioners,

I am sure many of you feel that these are dark times. I hardly need to enumerate the reasons. I remind myself that this is my time to live and die. I was born at a certain time and I will die at a certain time. In God's plan, my time really is certain. This is the time of my redemption and sanctification. As the poet William Blake so beautifully said, "And we are put on earth a little space, that we may learn to bear the beams of love." Let us not waste time complaining about these "terrible times." We are not good at judging the distance between good times and bad times. The reflection below is from the Carmelite Nuns in Lafayette, Louisiana.

"I love all that he does." St. Therese spoke these words during her last illness, when she was enduring excruciating physical and spiritual suffering. We might be tempted to exclaim: "Really? You love these pains, this anguish, this spiritual darkness, and sense of abandonment? God has let all this misery come upon you and you say, 'I love all that He does?' No way!"

As exaggerated as St. Therese's statement may sound to us who are not saints, she meant every word of it. But how can anyone, saint or sinner, LOVE pain, suffering, anguish, deprivation, and distress? Therese was not a stoic, glorying in her human strength. She was little and humble, filled with the wisdom of the saints. There is not one of these who has not valued suffering as a great gift of God because they knew it made them like Jesus, who, "for the sake of the joy set before Him, endured the cross, heedless of its shame" (Heb. 12:2.) They knew that suffering, accepted with love and patience, is the most efficacious means of spiritual purification because it cleanses our souls of the sins, weaknesses and manifold imperfections that cling to us in our sinful condition. And, through Faith they knew that their trials and troubles were permitted by their heavenly Father who is "nothing but mercy and love" and who never will permit anything that is not ultimately for His children's good, even though it may not seem so at the time.

St. Therese is called the saint of Hope. She can also be called the saint of Faith because she practiced Faith to such a heroic degree. Perhaps we may never reach the heights of Faith Therese achieved. Still, this supernatural virtue was instilled in us at Baptism and grows in our souls each time we accept God's will for us and strive to conform ourselves to it with love.

As we prepare for St. Therese's feast day on October 1st, let us ask St. Therese to enlighten and strengthen us in the acceptance of all that our merciful Father sends into our lives. She will surely help us, as surely as she will intercede for the needs and intentions we place in her care during the novena in her honor.

Let us join to make a novena to St. Therese from September 23-Octpber 1.
