### FAREWELL MESSAGE

I, Fr. Godfrey Leega Chandya of the Cross, in my farewell message, would like to thank the Discalced Carmelite Community members of Santa Cruz and the Parishioners of Santa Cruz Catholic Church in the words of St. Paul to the Philippians; Dear brothers, sisters, friends, young people, 'I thank my God, each time I think of you and when I pray, I pray with gladness' These are the words of St. Paul.

It was on March 21, 2016 when I arrived in Los Angeles, U.S.A., spent a day in Alhambra and two nights at the Retreat House in Redlands. Then on March 24, 2016, Fr.Stephen Watson who was by then the Provincial Superior of the Discalced Carmelites of California – Arizona Province, drove me down to Tucson, Arizona. It was Holy Thursday. This was my first assignment ever since I got to U.S.A. When I arrived at Santa Cruz Catholic Church, I stated the following; 'I hope I can be the priest that the Lord wants me to be. I am truly edified and have grown through the diverse experiences I have had both in the community and the parish. The few challenges could become the stepping stones for me to serve better at the new place of my assignment.

Whatever I have truly experienced can't be reproduced or reinvented elsewhere, for the community and the parish remains unique and special. I am glad to have experienced that uniqueness and specialty. As I look back on the four and a half years spent here in the community and the parish, I would like to share my gratitude and insight. Most of all, I would like to offer my gratitude to the Superior and Pastor of Santa Cruz Community and Parish, Fr. Stephen Watson, the Community members, the Parishioners and Santa Cruz Catholic School, for whatever you have done for me. God bless and keep you safe. You have been there in every thought, activity and prayer that I raised up to God. You have witnessed to Christ. You have been part of my ministry and community life. Thank you for everything that you have done for me. I would like to see and hear you do more and more as great people doing great works for God and his children. Please, where I have failed to learn from you, I ask for pardon from you. I would like to thank God for the four and a half years spent with you in the community and at Santa Cruz Catholic Church.

Farewells are not easy and as Catholics and Carmelites we understand fully well that this type of farewell to the Community and the Parishioners whom I have served for four and a half years is common and is needed in the Church. There is something very wonderful about being involved with the community members and the parishioners, living the life of Carmel and coming to the faith as seen in the different activities and ministries of the Community and the Parish. Both the Community and the Parish accepted me in a way I could never have anticipated. Getting to know the Community, the places, the people and their culture etc. has been just what I needed. I am a better Carmelite and a priest because of them.

Last but not the least, I am not only sent on a mission by the Provincial Superior, to my new assignment. I am sent by you also. You are also part of this mission. What I have experienced, whatever inspired and unfolded in through the Community and the Parish will inspire and help me to open to a greater world and God.


