Message from the Pastor ...

Dear Parishioners of Santa Cruz Parish,

"Peace be with you!" This is the greeting of the Lord Jesus to His disciples, who were fearful, overcome with grief and in sheer disbelief at seeing the risen Lord. Jesus wants to reassure His disciples that He is offering them His forgiveness and His mercy. His Divine Mercy. If we stop to think a moment on the actions of the Apostles on the night of the Last Supper we should realize how necessary it was for the Lord to make known to them His love and mercy for them.

When the Lord foretold that one of them would betray Him, they all swore that they would do no such thing, even Judas Iscariot, the betrayer, denies his actions. St. Peter we all know swears that he would never deny the Lord, even if it meant going to death for Him. A few hours later he is swearing that he does not know the man. When Jesus is being arrested, all the Apostles desert Him. At the trial before Pilate, they are no where to be found leading the crowd to ask for the release of the Lord instead of Barabbas. Only St. John is at the Cross with the Blessed Mother and the other women. None of them remain to claim the body of Jesus, not wanting to be identified as His followers. It is only the women who go to the tomb on the third day and find it empty. And even when they give witness to the Resurrection of the Lord, they refuse to believe. Is it any wonder that when they see the Lord alive and standing before them, they would be filled with shame, guilt, remorse and despair, instead of joy and gladness?

"Peace be with you!" This Sunday is known as Divine Mercy Sunday because it is on this day and in this Gospel where Jesus officially institutes the Sacrament of Penance (Confession/Reconciliation). When the Lord breathes on each of the Apostles and says to them: "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive, are forgiven them, whose sins you retain are retained," (*John 20:22-23*), He is giving them the power and the authority to forgive sins in His name. When we confess our sins, we are actually hearing the same message from the Lord: "Peace be with you!" Peace comes to us when we are reconciled with one another, when we forgive one another.

Peace comes to us from God because Jesus has reconciled us to the Father through His death and resurrection and given the Holy Spirit to the bishops and priests of the Catholic Church, so that the people might continue to experience the divine mercy of God.

Mensaje del Párroco ...

Estimados Feligreses de la Parroquia de Santa Cruz,

"¡La paz sea con ustedes!" Este es el saludo del Señor Jesús a sus discípulos, quienes estaban temerosos, afligidos por el dolor y por pura incredulidad al ver al Señor resucitado. Jesús quiere asegurar a sus discípulos que les ofrece su perdón y su misericordia. Su Divina Misericordia. Si nos detenemos a pensar un momento en las acciones de los Apóstoles la noche de la Última Cena, nos daremos cuenta de cuán necesario fue que el Señor les hiciera conocer su amor y misericordia para con ellos.

Cuando el Señor predijo que uno de ellos lo traicionaría, todos juraron que no harían tal cosa, incluso Judas Iscariote, el traidor, niega sus acciones. San Pedro que todos conocemos jura que nunca negaría al Señor, incluso si eso significara morir por Él. Unas horas más tarde jura que no conoce al hombre. Cuando arrestan a Jesús, todos los Apóstoles lo abandonan. En el juicio ante Pilato, no se les encuentran en la multitud para pedir la liberación del Señor en lugar de Barrabás. Sólo San Juan está en la Cruz con la Santísima Virgen y las demás mujeres. Ninguno de ellos se quedan para reclamar el cuerpo de Jesús, ya que no quieren ser identificados como sus seguidores. Son sólo las mujeres las que van al sepulcro al tercer día y lo encuentran vacío. E incluso cuando dan testimonio de la resurrección del Señor, se niegan a creer. ¿Es de extrañar, que cuando miran al Señor vivo y de pie ante de ellos, se llenen de vergüenza, culpa, remordimiento y desesperación, en lugar de gozo y alegría?

"¡La paz sea con ustedes!" Este domingo se conoce como Domingo de la Divina Misericordia porque es en este día y en este Evangelio donde Jesús instituye oficialmente el Sacramento de la Penitencia (Confesión/Reconciliación). Cuando el Señor sopla sobre cada uno de los Apóstoles y les dice: "Recibid el Espíritu Santo. A quienes perdonéis los pecados, les serán perdonados, a quienes retengáis los pecados, les serán retenidos" (*Juan 20:22-23*), Él les está dando el poder y la autoridad para perdonar pecados en Su nombre. Cuando confesamos nuestros pecados, en realidad estamos escuchando el mismo mensaje del Señor: "¡Paz a ustedes!" La paz nos llega cuando nos reconciliamos unos con otros, cuando nos perdonamos unos a otros.

La paz nos viene de Dios porque Jesús nos ha reconciliado con el Padre a través de su muerte y resurrección y ha dado el Espíritu Santo a los obispos y sacerdotes de la Iglesia católica, para que el pueblo siga experimentando la divina misericordia de Dios.
