Do Not Sign Abortion Campaign in Arizona

Pro-abortion Signature Campaign in Arizona

Millions of dollars from the pro-abortion industry are flooding into Arizona from out of State. This includes paying workers to collect signatures in front of grocery stores and other public locations for an amendment to our State Constitution.

Do not sign pro-abortion campaign in Arizona.

The goal of the signature campaign is to enshrine a constitutional right to unrestricted abortion in Arizona. What makes a constitutional amendment especially grave is that our own Arizona Legislators could lose the ability to regulate abortion in any way, leaving us with the potential for fully unrestricted abortion.

The proposed amendment would put women and girls at risk by no longer requiring the use of a qualified medical doctor as well as by removing safety standards for abortion clinics. By eliminating current parental consent laws, mothers and fathers would be left out of decision-making when their minor daughter needs them the most. Too, the proposed amendment would allow for painful late-term abortions and open the door to taxpayer funding them. While the effort claims to be moderate in nature, its vague language would make Arizona one of the most extreme states in terms of abortion. We believe that even many of those who support abortion in limited instances would find the proposed Constitutional amendment extreme and misleading.

Arizonans deserve far better than the measures being proposed in this signature campaign. We humbly ask for your prayers that this signature campaign will fail and that mothers and their babies will be kept alive and safe.

Again, we urge the citizens of Arizona not to sign when approached by these paid canvassers in front of stores or public locations.

Campaña No Firme el Aborto en Arizona

Campaña de firmas a favor del aborto en Arizona

Millones de dólares de la industria pro-aborto están llegando en Arizona desde fuera del estado. Esto incluye pagar a los trabajadores para que colecten firmas frente a las tiendas y otros lugares públicos para una enmienda a nuestra Constitución Estatal.

No firmes la campaña pro-aborto en Arizona.

El objetivo de la campaña de firmas es consagrar el derecho constitucional al aborto sin restricciones en Arizona. Lo que hace que una enmienda constitucional sea especialmente grave es que nuestros propios Legisladores de Arizona podrían perder la capacidad de regular el aborto, dejándonos con la posibilidad de un aborto totalmente irrestringido.

La enmienda propuesta pondría en riesgo a mujeres y niñas al no exigir más el uso de un médico calificado y al eliminar las normas de seguridad para las clínicas de aborto. Al eliminar las leyes actuales sobre el consentimiento de los padres, ellos quedarían fuera de las decisiones al respecto de su hija menor de edad cuando más los necesita. Además, la enmienda propuesta permitiría abortos dolorosos en etapas tardías del embarazo y abriría la puerta a que los contribuyentes de impuestos sean los financieros. Si bien el esfuerzo pretende ser de naturaleza moderada, su lenguaje dudoso convertiría a Arizona en uno de los estados más extremos en términos del aborto. Creemos que incluso muchos de los que apoyan el aborto en casos limitados encontrarán la propuesta a la enmienda Constitucional extrema y engañosa.

Los Arizonenses merecen medidas mucho mejores que las propuestas en esta campaña de firmas. Humildemente pedimos sus oraciones para que esta campaña de firmas fracase y para que las madres y sus bebés se mantengan vivos y seguros.

Nuevamente, les suplicamos a los ciudadanos de Arizona a no firmar cuando estos encuestadores pagados se les acerquen en las tiendas o lugares públicos.

Fast and Abstinence - Ash Wednesday and Good Friday
The Lenten regulations regarding fasting are as follows:

Fast: All people from age 18 to age 59 are required to fast. This means one full meal for the day (and if necessary, two smaller meals maybe taken that do not equal the full meal). Fasting is required on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Abstinence: Abstaining refers to not eating meat or chicken for the day. This applies to everyone from the age of 14 and up. We are called to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays during Lent.

Las normas de Cuaresma relativas al ayuno son las siguientes:

Ayuno: todas las personas entre 18 y 59 años deben ayunar. Esto significa una comida completa para el día (y si es necesario, se pueden tomar dos comidas más pequeñas que no equivalgan a la comida completa). Se requiere ayunar el Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo.

Abstinencia: Abstinencia se refiere a no comer carne o pollo durante el día. Esto se aplica a todas las personas a partir de los 14 años. Estamos llamados a abstenernos de comer carne el Miércoles de Ceniza y todos los viernes de Cuaresma.
