Message from the Pastor . . .

Dear Parishioners of Santa Cruz Parish,

Next week, July 17 - 21, Catholics from all over the country will be gathering in Indianapolis for the 10th National Eucharistic Congress seeking to awaken a movement of Revival of our faith in the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist. In 2019 the Pew Research Center conducted a survey that found one-third of U.S. Catholics agree with the church that the Eucharist is the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. According to Pew's analysis published in August 2019, "nearly seven-in-ten Catholics (69 percent) say they personally believe that during Catholic Mass, the bread and wine used in Communion **'are symbols of the body and blood of Jesus Christ.'** Just one-third of U.S. Catholics (31 percent) say they believe that **'during Catholic Mass, the bread and wine actually become the body and blood of Jesus.'**" (www.catholicreview.org). In other words, a majority of Catholics do not believe or understand what the Catholic Faith teaches about the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist. Do you?

Our belief that Jesus Christ is truly and really present in the Holy Eucharist, Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity, is at the heart of whom we are as disciples and followers of the Lord. It was He who said to the Apostles on the night of the Last Supper, "Take this, all of you and eat of it. For this is my Body, which will be given up for you. Take this all of you, and drink from it, this is my Blood." As Catholics we are called to believe that at the consecration of the bread and wine at Mass, the bread and wine are changed in substance from bread and wine into the substance of the Body and Blood of the Lord Jesus Christ. We call this process of change "transubstantiation". Once the consecration has taken place, there no longer remains any bread or wine on the altar. The miracle of the Eucharist is that the appearance of the bread and wine remain but the substance has changed. So that whatever can be seen, touched or tasted after the consecration is now truly and really the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ, present whole and entire in every part and drop of the Eucharist.

Because we know that it is truly Jesus Christ whom we are receiving in Holy Communion, we must do everything we can to prepare ourselves spiritually and mentally to be aware of Whom we are receiving. It is truly a gift of our Catholic faith to know that Jesus gives Himself to us every time we receive Him in Holy Communion.

Mensaje del Párroco . . .

Estimados Feligreses de la Parroquia de Santa Cruz,

La semana que viene, del 17 al 21 de julio, católicos de todo el país se reunirán en Indianápolis para el 10º Congreso Eucarístico Nacional, que busca despertar un movimiento de renacimiento de nuestra fe en la presencia real de Jesucristo en la Sagrada Eucaristía. En 2019, el Pew Research Center realizó una encuesta que encontró que un tercio de los católicos estadounidenses están de acuerdo con la iglesia en que la Eucaristía es el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Jesucristo. Según el análisis de Pew publicado en agosto de 2019, "casi siete de cada diez católicos (69 por ciento) dicen que creen personalmente que durante la misa católica, el pan y el vino utilizados en la comunión **'son símbolos del cuerpo y la sangre de Jesucristo'**. Solo un tercio de los católicos estadounidenses (31 por ciento) dicen creer que **'durante la misa católica, el pan y el vino en realidad se convierten en el cuerpo y la sangre de Jesús'**" (www.catholicreview.org). En otras palabras, la mayoría de los católicos no creen ni entienden lo que enseña la fe católica sobre la presencia real de Jesucristo en la Sagrada Eucaristía. ¿Y usted?

Nuestra creencia de que Jesucristo está verdaderamente presente en la Sagrada Eucaristía, Cuerpo, Sangre, Alma, y Divinidad, está en el corazón de quienes somos como discípulos y seguidores del Señor. Fue Él quien dijo a los Apóstoles en la noche de la Última Cena: "Tomen y coman todos de él. Porque esto es mi Cuerpo, que será entregado por ustedes. Tomen y beban todos de él, esta es mi Sangre". Como católicos estamos llamados a creer que en la consagración del pan y el vino en la Misa, el pan y el vino se transforman en sustancia de pan y vino en la sustancia del Cuerpo y la Sangre del Señor Jesucristo. Llamamos a este proceso de cambio "transubstanciación". Una vez que se ha realizado la consagración, ya no queda más pan ni vino en el altar. El milagro de la Eucaristía es que la apariencia del pan y del vino permanece pero la sustancia ha cambiado. De modo que todo lo que se puede ver, tocar o saborear después de la consagración es ahora verdadera y realmente el Cuerpo y la Sangre, el Alma y la Divinidad de Jesucristo, presente íntegramente en cada parte y gota de la Eucaristía.

Porque sabemos que es verdaderamente Jesucristo a quien estamos recibiendo en la Sagrada Comunión, debemos hacer todo lo posible para prepararnos espiritual y mentalmente para ser conscientes de A Quién estamos recibiendo. Es verdaderamente un don de nuestra fe católica saber que Jesús se nos da cada vez que lo recibimos en la Sagrada Comunión.
