First Sunday of Advent 2022

"Come, let us climb the LORD's mountain, to the house of the God of Jacob, that he may instruct us in his ways, and we may walk in his paths," Is. 2:3

Advent is the beginning of a new liturgical year. For this reason, we can think of the Frist Sunday of Advent as the Church's New Year. There is an interesting history behind this. In the early Christian centuries, Christmas Day marked the beginning of the new year in many countries. By the ninth century, parts of southern Europe began observing the first day of the new year on March 25 to coincide with the Annunciation of the Lord nine months prior to Christmas. In fact, in Latin, September means seventh month, October means eighth month, November means ninth month, and December means tenth month. When Pope Gregory XIII promulgated an updated calendar in 1582 (the former Julian calendar was out of sync with the sun), January 1 was established as the first day of the new year. But the fact that Advent begins a new year of worship reminds us of the Christian idea that that the birth of Christ is a new beginning. That is also why March 25 was once the Christian New Year since Our Lord was conceived in the womb of Mary. "The Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us," Jn.1:14. This was the beginning of the new creation in Christ. "Behold, I make all tings new," Rev.21:5. The birth of Our Savior Jesus Christ is our greatest reason for hope, to begin anew.

Each Sunday gospel of Advent has a specific theme; the Lord's coming in glory at the end of time (first Sunday), John the Baptist (second and third Sunday), and the events which immediately prepared for the Lord's birth (fourth Sunday). The Old Testament readings of Advent are prophecies about the Messiah and messianic times, especially those from the Book of Isaiah. The selections from the writings of the apostles present exhortations and instructions on different themes of Advent.

During Advent we also contemplate the role of the Blessed Virgin Mary in God's plan for the salvation of humanity. Mary is the New Eve without whom there is no Savior. It is wonderful that we celebrate the Immaculate Conception during Advent. The people of Nicaragua have their Gritería: "¿Quién causa tanta alegría?" "La Concepción de María". "Who causes so much joy?" "The Conception of Mary." The people of Mexico have given us La Morena, Our Lady of Guadalupe whose feast we also celebrate in Advent. Mary is the star of Advent, the mother of divine hope, and the cause of our joy. Ven con nosotros, Maria. Come with us, Virgin Mary.

In conclusion, I want to share part of a famous sermon of St. Bernard that is read in the Church during Advent.

You have heard, O Virgin, that you will conceive and bear a son; you have heard that it will not be by man but by the Holy Spirit. The angel awaits an answer; it is time for him to return to God who sent him. We too are waiting, O Lady, for your word of compassion; the sentence of condemnation weighs heavily upon us.

Tearful Adam with his sorrowing family begs this of you, O loving Virgin, in their exile from Paradise. Abraham begs it, David begs it. All the other holy patriarchs, your ancestors, ask it of you, as they dwell in the country of the shadow of death. This is what the whole earth waits for, prostrate at your feet. It is right in doing so, for on your word depends comfort for the wretched, ransom for the captive, freedom for the condemned, indeed, salvation for all the sons of Adam, the whole of your race.

Answer quickly, O Virgin. Reply in haste to the angel, or rather through the angel to the Lord. Answer with a word, receive the Word of God. Speak your own word, conceive the divine Word. Breathe a passing word, embrace the ~ Blessed Advent, Fr. Stephen F. Watson, O.C.D. eternal Word.
