REGISTRATION

To participate, skaters must be Wenatchee Figure Skating Club members **OR** in Learn-to-Skate with a Learn-to-Skate membership.

To register, bring the completed form (last 2 pages of this document) to the community rink and place it in the black WFSC dropbox (located under the TV, next to the office) OR email it to Vicki Campbell (Rachel Campbell's mom) at vicki.wenatcheefsc@gmail.com .

Registration fees can be paid online or with a check.

The fee to participate is stated below. Payments can be made online at [2026 Online Registration Payment link](#) or by check, payable to "WFSC". This fee allows skaters to participate in the songs learned during the Sunday practices. For WFSC members, this includes the opening, closing, bows, and large group number(s). Learn to skate participants will be in a large group number and bows.

Cost per 1st WFSC Skaters	\$150
Cost per additional WFSC Skaters	\$110
Cost per 1st LTS Skaters	\$100
Cost per additional LTS Skaters	\$ 80

The registration fee does not include coaching and freestyle fees associated with small groups or solos, which are learned during free style sessions.

Skaters must have their own skates to participate. Coach Teka (teka@engagencw.com) has several used pairs available for purchase. TTC rental skates are not permitted.

For us to have the best possible show, Sunday rehearsal attendance is required. Practice time is limited so please plan to be there for all of your scheduled number practices, dress rehearsal and any off-ice practices.

- ☐ I will participate in the performance, the full run-through and the dress rehearsal.
- ☐ I understand that the show's director will make all final decisions in regards to the Holiday Ice Show music, costumes and performances.
- ☐ I will help to promote the show to my best ability and will enthusiastically try to sell tickets to friends, family and neighbors.
- ☐ I understand that if I miss more than **two** rehearsals, I will not be able to participate in that number. (Prior arrangements need to be cleared by the Ice Show Committee)
- ☐ If I am cast to perform a solo, I will be responsible for my costume and arrangements for private lessons to put together the choreography / make sure the solo is ready for performance.
- ☐ If I would like a solo, duet, trio, or quartet I will arrange for private coaching lessons, and attend freestyles a minimum of 2 times a week from October through December 19.. If performing in a small group I will coordinate with the other skaters and our coach so we can practice ALL TOGETHER.
- ☐ If I use a WFSC costume, I will be responsible for all my costumes, I will not permanently alter it without prior approval and will pay a fee to replace or repair the costume if it is lost or damaged.
- ☐ I will keep the ice show director updated on any changes to my e-mail address and I will check my e-mail weekly for updates. I will also communicate and be responsive.
- ☐ My parent/guardian/family member has agreed to fulfill the parent expectations – provide items for concessions sale; ensure sufficient supervision is provided in their skater's locker room (including taking SafeSport training and fulfilling SafeSport requirements); help with set-up and tear-down for the dress rehearsal and show; provide props for my numbers if necessary; and sign up for *at least* one volunteering option (below)
- ☐ I understand that off-ice and on-ice practices are mandatory and off-ice practices might require transportation to another location outside of TTC.
