Board Meeting Minutes

Date: Thursday, April 16, 2026

Location: Conference Room (2nd Floor) at Town Toyota Center

The meeting was called to order at 5:52 p.m.

1. Club Financial Report

Vicki presented an updated financial report as of April 16, 2026 (report via email). The club's bank balance currently stands at \$68,974.18. It was also noted that the club still needs to complete and file the 2024 tax return, followed subsequently by the 2025 tax return.

2. Annual Club Meeting Date and Arrangements

The Board discussed and proposed dates for the upcoming Annual Club Meeting. The primary option is Tuesday, June 9th, with a secondary option of Tuesday, June 2nd should the Crunch Pak Room at the Town Toyota Center be unavailable.

The meeting will be held at the Crunch Pak Room, Town Toyota Center, from approximately 5:30 PM to 7:00 PM, following the club freestyle session.
