


DRESS CODE



Hair should be pulled back and away from the face securely.

Ballet buns are preferred.

Do not wear recital or dress up costumes to class.

No skirts or tutus are allowed. We discourage wearing dance shorts; if they must be worn, please make sure that they are the same color as your leotard.

No outside shoes are allowed in the classrooms AT ANY TIME. **DO NOT WEAR ANY DANCE SHOES OUTSIDE!**

Necklaces/bracelets or any distracting jewelry is not allowed in class.

Only plain water is allowed in classrooms; no flavored or colored drinks. No food is allowed.

No electronic devices or watches allowed in classrooms. Stop by the desk or ask your teacher for a "phone jail" pocket to store your devices during class.

BALLET CLASSES:

- Shoes – Split sole ballet slippers - if there are drawstrings, tie them in a double knot and cut off excess.
 - Females – ballet pink
 - Males – black



- Female attire
 - Solid black or teal leotard (no patterns), no leotards with skirts or shorts attached
 - Ballet pink tights (footed or convertible), make sure tights are pulled down completely over your feet in shoes.
 - Advanced level dancers may wear teacher-approved ballet skirts. Check with your teacher prior to wearing a skirt. Shorts are not allowed without prior approval.
- Male attire
 - Black or teal, fitted dance shirt
 - Fitted dance pants, or tights, or bike shorts (no athletic shorts).

POINTE CLASSES:

- Same attire as ballet class. Instructors will advise you on pointe shoes.

JAZZ CLASSES:

- Shoes
 - All levels – tan, split sole, lace less gore boot



- Female attire
 - Solid black or teal leotard (no patterns), no leotards with skirts attached
 - Ballet pink tights (footed or convertible), make sure tights are pulled down completely over your feet in shoes.
 - Advanced level dancers may wear teacher-approved ballet skirts. Check with your teacher prior to wearing a skirt.
- Male attire
 - Black or teal, fitted dance shirt
 - Fitted dance pants, or tights, or bike shorts (no athletic shorts)

BALLET & MOVEMENT ARTS CLASSES:

- Shoes
 - Ballet – see ballet above on dress code
- Female attire
 - Same as ballet for leotards
 - Ballet pink tights (must be convertible)
- Male attire
 - Same as ballet

TAP CLASSES:

- Shoes
 - For fall Monday classes, Tan Mary Jane buckle taps



- For fall Tuesday classes (& all boys) Black, full sole, oxford taps



- Female attire
 - Solid black or teal leotard (no patterns), no leotards with skirts attached
 - Ballet pink tights (footed or convertible), make sure tights are pulled down completely over your feet in shoes.
 - Advanced level dancers may wear teacher-approved ballet skirts. Check with your teacher prior to wearing a skirt.
 - Warm up pants may be worn with prior teacher approval.
- Male attire
 - Black or teal, fitted dance shirt
 - Fitted dance pants, or tights, or bike shorts (no athletic shorts)

TUMBLE/MODERN/CONTEMPORARY CLASSES:

- Shoes
 - Barefoot
- Female attire
 - Solid black or teal leotard (no patterns), no leotards with skirts attached
 - Ballet pink or tan tights (convertible, footless, or stirrup) – if class is consecutive with other classes, please make sure to maintain appropriate tights for the other classes
- Male attire
 - Black or teal, fitted dance shirt
 - Fitted dance pants, or tights, or bike shorts (no athletic shorts)

HIP HOP CLASSES:

- Shoes ***NO STREET SHOES ALLOWED***
 - Black
 - Dance sneakers with smooth soles



- On Amazon, you can search for “Light up shoes, high top sneakers” make sure you look at the bottom and ensure it is smooth like pictured above. Please note the Amazon shoes are light up, and are acceptable for class.
- Attire
 - Comfortable, non-restrictive dance attire
 - No jeans or dresses

THEATRE/VOICE CLASSES:

- Shoes
 - Barefoot, jazz shoes, or clean socks
- Attire
 - Comfortable, non-restrictive attire
 - No jeans or dresses
