KLC Loss Control Survey

(Hodgenville, KY) – On January 25th, 2024, the Kentucky League of Cities conducted a Loss Control Survey of the Hodgenville Police Department. This survey is used to determine the liability posed by an agency to our insurance provider, the Kentucky League of Cities.

HPS scored 91.78%. The three areas we need to improve on are firearms, driving and accreditation.

- 1. Our firearms range does not include a moving target system; therefore, we did not receive points for that category. Although we qualify annually, we will be adding some type of moving target into the qualifications in the future.
- 2. Driver's training is also done in accordance with HB298. Officers are required to complete drivers training every two years. In order to comply with the KLC survey, we will be adding a cones course to our training each year.
- 3. The third area we received no points in was accreditation. Accreditation through the Kentucky Association of Chiefs of Police is something we have wanted to achieve for many years; however, the process is costly and it has taken us several years to get within achieving the standard required to become accredited. We are moving to become accredited by the end of 2024.

The score we received is very good for an agency the size of HPD and we are proud of our accomplishment. This will qualify HPD for a 12% credit toward the cost of our insurance. That is a savings to the city and one more way HPD is helping our community!
