FSCDC SSA #45 Quick Facts

What is a Special Service Area?

A Special Service Area (SSA) is an economic development tool that provides neighborhoods with the financial means to create, maintain, and manage clean, attractive and competitive commercial districts. SSAs (also known as Business Improvement Districts) provide a fair, transparent way to finance and manage improvement programs and provide supplemental services. There are over 50 SSAs in the City of Chicago.

How does it work?

A supplemental property tax levy is applied to properties within the SSA and funds collected are used for beautification and enhancements such as holiday decor, art installations, sidewalk cleaning, snow removal, façade improvements and more. By providing these services year after year, FSCDC SSA #35 fosters a vibrant, inviting and safe community for all.

What informs SSA actions?

FSCDC SSA #45 is guided by a volunteer commission of local business owners, property owners, and residents and administered by the Far South CDC. The commission meets quarterly to oversee all budgeting and work plans. All SSA meetings are open to the public. SSA #45 and the Far South CDC is building on the momentum from being selected as one of the 2022 Chicago Prize finalists and recipient of Chicago's Department of Housing's Low-Income Housing Tax Credits for Morgan Park Commons at the northwest corner of 115th and Halsted.






About SSA #45

Boundaries + Connections

With more than 32 blocks of sidewalk along the South Halsted Gateway Corridor – with arterial streets of 103rd, 111th, 115th, and 119th – is one of the most intermodal-friendly SSAs in the City of Chicago. As depicted in the thick blue outline in the map below, SSA #45 connects public and commercial amenities through public transit nodes and a historic bike trail.

2022 Annual Budget: District Impact

Nearly \$1.07 million dollars were applied to SSA #45 in 2022. The improvements covers more than 32 commercial blocks that touch four neighborhoods, including Washington Heights, East Morgan Park, Roseland, and West Pullman.

Clean + Maintenance

Far South CDC's SSA #45 2022 is dedicated to keeping the South Halsted corridor sidewalks and streets clean. This program, under SSA #45, provides **litter** abatement and debris removal, recycling, trash collection and disposal of public garbage containers, removal signage from public light poles and the street median, and maintains the newly developed POP! Heights Park.

POP! HEIGHTS PARK @ 112TH/HALSTED

Far South CDC's SSA #45 will provide ongoing maintenance of POP! Heights Park with litter and debris removal, removal of illegal signs and printed solicitations, and recycling. The maintenance contractor, Cleanslate by Cara, will coordinate with the landscaping contractor to ensure the park is will maintained for public use. The park hours are Monday – Sunday from 8:00am to 8:00pm.

Preserving our Environment

Far South CDC's SSA #45 is dedicated to improving the corridor and the Major Taylor Trail with recommendations to add benches, bike racks, and public transit enhancements. Additionally, SSA #45 added **Paper Shredding** to encourage the community residents and local businesses to responsibly recycle paper and old technology equipment.

In partnership with Midway Moving and Storage Company, Far South CDC SSA #45 hosted three Paper Shredding and Electronic Waste Recycling at the northwest corner of 115th and Halsted (former Halsted Mall and Jewel Grocery Store). The events were at no costs to the community.

Fernwood Entertainment District @ 99th/Halsted

In May 2022, Far South CDC's "Bringing Communities Back Initiative" was selected as one of the six finalists for the \$10 million Chicago Prize grant from the Pritzker Traubert Foundation, which included three proposed projects within SSA #45 district.



The **Fernwood Entertainment District** is a proposed 50 unit mixed-used residential building with 8K square feet of retail, and 10K square foot arts and shared kitchen center to replace the existing Grand Motel.







Morgan Park Commons is uniquely situated between three neighborhoods, including East Morgan Park, West Pullman, and Roseland. The proposed project seeks to develop 286 units of affordable housing units with 18,750 square feet of retail.














Public Safety

Having a Safe Corridor is Essential to District Growth

The Public Health and Safety is a top priority for SSA #45. Nearly 30 percent of its \$1.07 million budget is spent on public safety. Far South CDC SSA #45 contracts with a third-party private security service, AGB Investigative Services, to provide security patrol within the SSA #45 boundaries six days per week and on special holidays. The private security coordinates with the local Chicago Police Department in keeping the area safe.

Distribution of Resources

Far South CDC's SSA #45 2022 Annual Budget generated more than \$1.07 million in funds for the South Halsted Corridor improvement. Majority of the budget (75% shown below) expended is to ensure **public safety** for residents visiting the businesses and for the businesses to operate in a **clean and comfortable environment** that attracts **economic development**.

Touring the District

Amenities & Attractions

Far South CDC's SSA #45 has many attraction in and around the district, including the newly established Far South CDC's Marketplace, POP! Heights Park, Maple Park Mini-Plaza and the historic Major Taylor Trail connecting to the south suburbs. South Halsted serves as a major connector to attractions outside of the district, including the Ray & Joan Kroc Center, Marshfield Plaza Shopping Center, and Pullman Redevelopment Park.



MARKETPLACE @ 115th/Halsted

The program is supported by a grant from the City of Chicago's Small Business Storefront Activation Program, which is focused on bringing retail vendors and artwork to 30 previously vacant storefronts in neighborhoods across the city. The Marketplace currently houses 10-women-owned businesses.



POP! HEIGHTS PARK @ 112th/Halsted

Pop! Heights is the first new park on South Halsted in over 50 years. A true amenity for gathering, play, and community. POP! Heights Park is divided into six primary zones of activity all linked by a lively, brightly colored walking ribbon that meanders throughout the site.



MAJOR TAYLOR TRAIL

Named after the historic Marshall "Major" Taylor who was an African-American bicycle racer and civil rights advocate, the Trail runs from the Dan Ryan Woods south to Whistler Woods. Along the Trail, SSA #45 maintains between 111th to 119th Streets.
