Through God's provision, we have partnered with **Big Oak Ranch**, a Christ-centered organization with **50 years of experience in restoring children's lives**. Their expertise is guiding us in establishing best practices as we develop Tennessee's **first healing ranch** exclusively for girls recovering from child sex trafficking.

This ranch will provide:

- **Christ-centered, trauma-informed homes** for girls recovering from trafficking.
- **On-site therapeutic services** covering spiritual, medical, psychological, and educational needs.
- **Christian house parents** for family-style healing (4-5 girls per home).
- **Facilities including** a chapel, school, medical center, recreation areas, equine therapy, and more.

After years of searching, we found the exact place Jesus had prepared—a breathtaking **84-acre estate in Middle Tennessee**.

- **Move-in ready healing home:** 6 bedrooms, 5 baths.
- **Additional home for a future ranch director.**
- **One of Tennessee's largest private equine therapy arenas** with 16 stalls and a built-in apartment.

Our Ranch is Under Contract —Now We Need You!

To open our doors and welcome the first rescued girl, we must overcome a few hurdles:

- 1. Home Sponsorship:** Each healing home is **sponsored by a family** as a legacy of hope. One home is already pledged at \$650,000; another sponsor is needed **this year** to secure the property.
- 2. Annual Operations:** Each home costs **\$250,000 per year** to provide full care for these girls.
- 3. Community Partnerships:** Individuals, businesses, and organizations can support construction, operations, and special projects.
- 4. Monthly Hero:** Monthly donations are the foundation of our stability and financial success.

Our Mission: Prevent. Rescue. Restore.

PREVENT: Stop Missing & Trafficking Before It Starts

We are equipping children and families with the awareness and knowledge to recognize dangerous situations and respond with the “safe choice”.

- **Over 160,000 children and families** reached through **150+ events** annually.
- A dedicated **Family Safety Outreach Center** at Hickory Ridge Mall.
- More than **16,000 free Child/Teen Safety ID Kits** professionally created onsite.

RESCUE: Bring Missing & Trafficked Children Home

The crisis is far greater than most realize. Hundreds of children are missing in Tennessee alone, many falling victim to child sex trafficking.

Assisted in **hundreds of missing child and trafficking cases**.

Expanded missing child awareness through **digital display alerts, social media, text alerts, and Tennessee's first Mobile Command Center for missing children**.

Built strong partnerships with law enforcement, private investigators, private security, and community groups to provide **free investigative and recovery services**.

RESTORE: Offering True Healing

Rescue alone is not enough. Many victims don't even recognize themselves as victims. Traffickers manipulate through false love, trust, and control—stripping children of their faith, hope, and identity.

I'll never forget one young girl we helped rescue **four times** between ages 12 and 14. The cycle continued because true healing wasn't available. In my brokenness, I asked Jesus what to do, and He gave me a vision... (next page)
