Funded by the U.S. Department of Justice, COPS Office the Crime Scene Operations Field Techniques course is designed to teach basic crime scene investigation techniques.

This hands-on training program offers sworn and non-sworn crime scene investigators and technicians access to forensic evidence identification, documentation, collection, and preservation procedures.

During the 40-hour block of instruction participants receive hands-on training in the areas of DNA evidence, fingerprinting, bloodstain pattern analysis, photography, evidence collection and packaging, documentation, crime scene sketching and more.

The course blends facilitated learning and lecture periods with mock crime scenes and provides a safe and effective training environment for crime scene personnel.
