COURSE DESCRIPTION: This 40 hour crime scene investigation course will provide students with basic knowledge and experience to process crime scenes and use their equipment. Numerous topics will be instructed including: legal standards, search warrants, scene preservation, photography, documentation, evidence collection, fingerprint evidence, DNA, trace evidence, ALS, footwear and other impression evidence collection. Students should bring what equipment their department provides to learn its use through hands-on training. Scene scenarios and practical exercises will be performed daily to prepare students with experience and confidence.

GOALS: The Goals of the Course are as follows

- -Learn proper response to crime scenes and how to secure the scene for processing.
- -Discuss legal considerations, case studies, and how to write a search warrant.
- -Familiarize students with the 7-Step scene protocol.
