MTU 13 will be hosting another Basic Tactical Medical course. In an overview, this course covers life threatening injuries to yourself and others. The instructor will teach how to properly assess the patient, how to conduct Rapid Trauma Surveys. He will also teach you how to properly apply a tourniquet as well as how to use Hemostatic agents and dressings, wound packing and treating the sucking chest wound. Many other topics of taking life saving measures to critically injured people will be covered here.

The peace officer of today must be prepared to meet many challenges. We carry firearms for the protection of life; this course will teach you how to treat those wounds that you are trained to inflict. The training you receive from this class could help you to save someone's life sometime in your career. That life may be a loved one or your own. This may be the most valuable training that you ever receive.

To assist you in saving your live or the life of someone else each officer will leave with two (2) deluxe trauma bandages and a tourniquet for their personal Individual Trauma Kit.

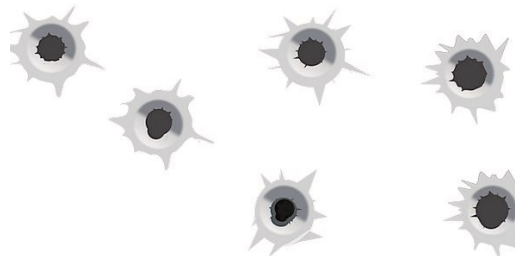
