Overview: One day course for tactical team operators to train on the distinct tactics required for bus hostage rescue. The course incorporates a short power point presentation on bus design characteristics and breaching options. There is a live fire range session to familiarize students on shooting from a ladder. The remaining curriculum focuses on the tasks required for the ladder team, entry team, breaching team and coordinating directives. Evacuation methods complete the training. Air Soft is incorporated into the bus scenarios.

Objectives:

Trainees participate as execute tasks as shown in drills for ladder, entry and breach teams.

Trainee can maneuver in extremely close proximity and maintain safe gun handling. As part of a team, trainee evacuates hostages from a bus in a coordinated and tactical perspective.

Directions:

From Rt. 316 (West State Street in Charleston). Turn South on Decker Springs Road. Take second right hand turn and follow the road around the curve. The training center is on your left.

From Rt. 16 (Reynolds Drive, This intersection will have a Marathon Station on the south side of the street and Lincoln Gardens Family Restaurant on the north) Turn north onto Reynolds Drive and follow that to the bottom of the hill where the road comes to a T. <-> Turn left and follow the road. It will take you under the railroad tracks. The road curves to the right, around a large building in the middle of the road. The training center will be just past it on the right.
