Course Overview

A five day course to train current instructors on how to conduct close quarters tactical training using conventional range configurations. The comprehensive curriculum builds on small team techniques and procedures for patrol level operations and incorporates larger team methods for tactical units. A major focus is on room clearing strategies at both patrol and tactical levels; dynamic for active shooter and hostage rescue, and systematic for building searches and similar applications. Pistol and carbine techniques are incorporated into the curriculum along with basic shield methods, contact & cover and officer support techniques. The course concludes with a simulated in-service training day session where instructor candidates prepare lesson plans and present a program of instruction as a graded student teaching exercise.

Directions:

From Rt. 316 (West State Street in Charleston). Turn South on Decker Springs Road. Take second right hand turn and follow the road around the curve. The training center is on your left.

It will take you under the railroad tracks. The road curves to the right, around a large building in the middle of the road. The training center will be just past it on the right.
