In both offices she has also been assigned to other major crimes including first degree murder cases. She is a member of several multi-disciplinary teams that focus on domestic and elder abuse, including founder and coordinator of the McLean County Coordinated Community Response Team and co-chair of the East Central Illinois Regional Fatality Review Team. She has provided training to police officers and professionals across the state on family violence and elder abuse, and is a legal instructor for the Macon County Law Enforcement Training Center.
