POLICE FIREARMS INSTRUCTOR COURSE

Overview: A 40 hour training course to provide instructor candidates with the fundamental skills to train entry level persons on essential pistol operating skills and conduct sustainment training for their agency. The curriculum maintains a major focus on instructor traits and teaching abilities, with numerous student teaching exercises in the classroom and range operations. Topics expound to low light training and more advance skills to provide a well-rounded aptitude to conduct on going training. Candidates will be versed in related legal concerns regarding use of force and liability.

The course concludes with a daylong graded student teaching exercises simulating an in-service training date. Candidates prepare written lesson plans and conducting individual blocks of instruction with a live fire range session. Each is graded by peers and the course instructor. Candidates also complete a written test and firearms proficiency course of fire.

INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

It is hereby agreed that in consideration of one of its employees.

being granted the opportunity of participating and engaging in in-service, advanced, refresher training, or operations, functions and other activities sanctioned by MTU 13.

Employing the above-named employee shall hold the **MTU 13** harmless as to any injuries or damages incurred by said employee as a result of such training, operations, functions, references provided and/or other activities sanctioned by **MTU 13** regardless of fault or negligence on the part of any official or employee of **MTU** except for gross negligence or willful, wanton or intentional misconduct.

The above employer shall further agree to indemnify **MTU 13** in the full amount of any judgment or claim awarded to the trainee, his/her heirs. Dependents and assigns for such injuries or damages sustained by said trainee during the official course of his or her temporary assignment to the training, except for gross negligence or willful, wanton or intentional misconduct.

It is further agreed that, should suit or claim be filed by said trainee alleging injury or damage as a result of **MTU 13's** training, operations, functions, references provided and/or other activities sanctioned by **MTU 13** reasonable notice of such suit or claim will be given to the department or agency employing the affected trainee; and said department or agency will appear and defend MTU 13.
