Course Description:

This is a course that will leave the students with an understanding of the basic steps they should follow upon arrival to any potential crime scene to which they respond. It will emphasize the importance of their role in the preliminary investigation and how vital these duties and responsibilities are towards attaining a successful conclusion to the subsequent investigation. Time and time again we see in the news investigations that are being criticized because they were not handled correctly from their beginning. Not after you attend this course. Emphasize the importance of their role in the preliminary investigation, and how vital these duties and responsibilities are towards attaining a successful conclusion to the subsequent investing. Explain the common basic principles and methods of criminal investigations. Provide case examples of the application of the above investigative principles and methods towards specific types of criminal investigations. Expose the student to different types of crime scenes to which they may come across as an initial responder. Discuss current issues that are pertinent to the student's knowledge and understanding of criminal investigations (i.e. resources, technology, DNA, witness identification practices, interrogation techniques, case law, etc.)

Explain concepts such as scene security, "kill zone", first aid duties, modus operandi, informant development and management, witness identification, neighborhood and business canvasses, intelligence and specialty unit resources, forensic animation, surveillance techniques, etc. to broaden the student's overall knowledge regarding proactive and reactive investigations.

Directions:

From Rt. 316 (West State Street in Charleston). Turn South on Decker Springs Road. Take second right hand turn and follow the road around the curve. The training center is on your left.

From Rt. 16 (Reynolds Drive, This intersection will have a Marathon Station on the south side of the street and Lincoln Gardens Family Restaurant on the north) Turn north onto Reynolds Drive and follow that to the bottom of the hill where the road comes to a T. <-> Turn left and follow the road. 

