OVERVIEW: Police Officers spend a majority of their shift working in and around their squad car. This two day course focuses on tactics and procedures involving high risk situations under the controlled range conditions. Training begins with a preliminary range session to set core skills. The remainder of that day involves training to counter attacks on officers white seated in their vehicle. The next day involves two officer exercises to simulate FTO status or two officer patrols during civil unrest. Post shooting support drills and person down rescue tactics are presented, along with weapon penetration tests to determine which parts of a vehicle provide ballistic protection.

Objectives:

 Trainee can perform solo tactics and procedures for countering an ambush attack while seating as demonstrated for front and side contacts, egressing the vehicle and using it for cover.
Trainee can perform two officer tactics and procedure for countering an ambush as demonstrated while coordinating movements and use of cover

Trainee can perform tactics and procedures for solo officer engagement on simulated traffic stop while using cover and time until back up officer arrives and coordinating follow up action to arrest suspect and/or provide medical aid.

Trainee maintains a better comprehension on ballistic protection afforded by vehicle areas.

Trainee can perform a hasty person down rescue as part of a small team while using the methods and procedures demonstrated.
