Instruction will cover the entire Vehicle Code and Illinois Supreme Court Rules concerning bonding procedures. In this course special attention will be given to the strict construction of the wording of traffic laws, procedures for charging a traffic offense, the major differences in enforcing violations of state laws and city ordinances, the application of Miranda warnings to traffic cases, the rights of vehicle occupants regarding searches and seizures, frequent problems encountered in traffic enforcement, and common bonding misconceptions and errors.
