Purpose of course: This dynamic 8 hour course has been specifically designed by the instructor, Detective Domenic Cappelluti (Street-Strategies, Inc.), to prepare all:

Detectives, Investigators, Agents, Supervisors, Command, Gang Officers and uniformed Patrol Officers in developing, cultivating and safely utilizing confidential informants (C.I.’s) when conducting criminal investigations within the direction and guidelines of their respective government agencies.
