"On the day of any primary, referendum or election no person shall solicit in behalf of or in opposition to another or himself or peddle or offer any ballot, advertizing matter or circular to another person or loiter within a radius of seventy-five feet of any outside entrance in use as an entry to any polling place or in any corridor, passageway or other approach leading from any such outside entrance to such polling place or in any room opening upon any such corridor, passageway or approach."

Election Worker Harassment

A new legislative act makes it a felony to influence or attempt to influence through force, threat, or harassment an election worker performing election administration duties. This applies to town clerks, registrars of voters, deputy registrars, and election, primary, and recanvass officials.

The act also makes it a misdemeanor to publicly disclose an election worker's personal identifying information with the intent to harass, terrorize, or alarm the worker or improperly influence them in performing their election administration duties.

Additionally, election workers have a civil cause of action against violators of either provision under the act (PA 24-148, § 7, effective July 1, 2024).

HOW TO USE THIS BALLOT
CAUTION: This ballot may consist of more than one sheet.

I. TO MARK THIS BALLOT.
Completely fill in each appropriate oval as shown. Use a black ballpoint pen. Do not mark the party names in any way.

II. TO VOTE FOR CANDIDATES.
In most cases, only one mark or written vote is allowable in each column. (That is, for each office.)

A. TO VOTE FOR CANDIDATES ON THE BALLOT.
Completely fill in the oval above the name of each candidate for whom you wish to vote.

Primary Voting Instructions

1. The names or names of party-endorsed candidates appear first in each vertical column and the name of each party-endorsed candidate is marked with an asterisk. If there is no party endorsement, the designation "no party endorsement" appears under the office or position designation.

2. Each candidate's oval is located just above his name; so be sure to fill in the oval of each candidate for whom you wish to vote. There is no write-in voting at primaries.

I. PARA MARCAR SU VOTO:

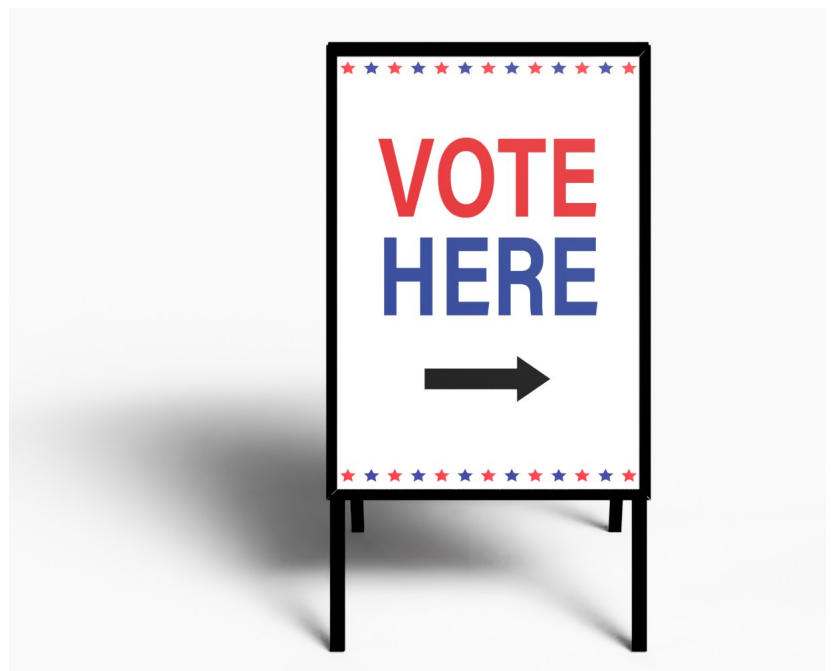
