As of 2023 the regions employment is expected to increase by 6% between 2023 and 2028, adding 169. This change is less than the state growth rate of 7% by 1%.










Top Industry Employment Concentration













Jun 2024 Labor Force Breakdown





Unemployment by Demographics



Unemployment by Age





Unemployment by Gender








Inbound and Outbound Migration
