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WORDS FROM THE PASTOR



Being involved in missions is about being involved in what God is doing. Jesus said, "My Father has been working until now, and I have been working . . . Most assuredly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of Himself, but what He sees the Father do; for what ever He does, the Son also does in like manner. For the Father loves the Son, and shows Him all things that He Himself does; and He will show Him greater works than these, that you may marvel." God is always at work in this world and He is inviting us to join Him in what He is doing. In order to join God, we need to deny ourselves and follow Jesus Christ. Jesus says, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and Io, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." The command is to go and the goal is to make disciples.

Being involved in missions means sharing the good news of Jesus Christ to lost humanity, transforming unbelievers into Christlike believers, teaching them to live the life that God intended for His people, and sending them back out to reach others for Christ. When we fail to be on mission, we have lost our effectiveness to be salt and light to our world. Remember that being lost "implies there was some place that you were suppose to be and someone cared that you were not there." God says that we are suppose to be in relationship with Him, but we are not. As a result, He sent His Son to seek and save that which is lost. Jesus says, **"As You sent Me into the world, I also have sent them into the world."** Let us turn our attention towards doing kingdom work by being focused on missions.

Eternal life begins the moment one receives Jesus Christ into his/her life by faith.

HOW WE BEGAN

In May 2007, the Lord gave me a vision of a new church plant during his quiet time with Him. At that time He gave me the name, mission statement, core values, and the discipleship process for this new work. The name God gave us is a constant reminder of who we are **NEW CREATION**, with the **BIBLE** as our foundation, and Christian **FELLOWSHIP** as our goal. As a result, I shared with Pastor Horacio S, Jones (pastor of Family Bible Fellowship) what the Lord had given me. With much prayer we began to pursue implementing this new work.

For the past several years, I had been praying over the site of a new elementary school in our neighborhood. After receiving the vision, I contacted the school to inquire about using their facilities. At the same time, Calvary Chapel of Tracy had just secured the usage of this new school. Therefore, I contacted Pastor Rob Krenik of Calvary to inquire about the facility they were leaving. I had never met him. He shared with me that they had a 2000 square foot building on two-acres that was available for use on Sundays. I then met with Pastor Rob and upon sharing with him the vision the Lord had given me, we secured the site as our new worship center.

Our next step focused on securing members and support. With the blessings of Pastor Jones, ten families from Family Bible Fellowship committed to support to this new work. Then we met with Dr. Jeffery Curtis and Dr. Joshua Smith from the CSBC African-Church Planting Department and begun the process of securing funding. As a result, we partnered with Dr. Lyman Alexander (DOM East Bay Baptist Association, Jerry Yates (DOM Delta Valley Association), Family Bible Fellowship, and the CSBC to begin this new work.

Our third step focused on reaching out to our community. Utilizing Aubrey Malphur's "Advanced Strategic Planning" and Nelson Searcy and Kerrick Thomas' "Launch" books, we held monthly worship services on the third Sunday's beginning in November 2007. In addition, nine core members attended the Basic Training for Church Planters seminar in Manteca in October 2007. February 10, 2008 marked the date of our first worship celebration to the community.

Our fourth step focused on identifying the "person of peace" in the City of Tracy. We began to develop relationships with key city officials and as a result, we met City Councilwoman Evelyn Tolbert. Through our relationship with Ms. Tolbert, we are now in collaboration with the Mayor's Community Youth Support Network which focuses on providing services to the Youth of Tracy. Since then, we have developed partnerships with the Tracy Convalescent & Rehabilitation Center, Tracy Crime Stoppers, Boys & Girls Club, and the Tracy Unified School District. In addition, we are partnering with the Restoration Center founded by Dr. James which is a Christian based non-profit which focuses on providing a school based mentoring and prevention program.

In August 2014, Dr. James approached the California Baptist Foundation seeking support to purchase the property the ministry was meeting at. With the support of Dr. Philip Kell and Doug Heffner, the foundation staff and Gary Singh of Crossroads Real Estate in Manteca, we were able to possess the property in May 2015.

We are witnessing God's faithfulness to His people as we continue to engage our culture for Christ. It is our passion to impact the lives of people with the love of Christ. The dedication of workers and members has resulted in our focus and determination to **"TO ADD VALUE TO OUR COMMUNITY."** The church has grown from 18 people to over 150+ and we have impacted the lives of over 1000 people through our ministry during our first year. 
