The boys have reported back to school this week. Schools run on the calendar year, and there are three terms per year, so they are reporting for third term. Earlier this week, there were 20 boys at Ahadi, having arrived from their visit



with a relative. A group from a Christian university called Kabarak, and a local AIC Turnup church group both came with donations of food and clothing and prepared a delicious lunch for the boys, played games, and had devotions together. This was a nice send-off to third term. It made for a very full house, but we are thankful for their generosity in gifts and time spent with the boys. It's a reminder to the Ahadi boys that money doesn't grow on trees but comes from the generosity of people

who sacrificially give because they care about them.

Please pray for continued support from Kenyans and for our boys to take seriously the need to study hard this final term.

CASE IN POINT: The police contacted the Ahadi manager with an unusual request. They had a boy in jail who had seriously harmed another boy to the extent that he had to be hospitalized for an extended time. Both families are poor, and the family of the harmed boy became very hostile, so that the guilty boy was jailed to protect him until the case takes off in court. Jail is no place for a child, but when the police called, the boy had been there already for three weeks! So, we took the boy off their hands and enrolled him in school with our boys last term. We hoped he wasn't violent in nature, and thankfully, he is not. He is happy and settling well at Ahadi and is doing great in school! Thank God. **Pray for a just resolution to the issue and for healing of the injured boy.**
