

## CFGC Policies and Procedures

**1. MEMBER GUESTS** – Members are entitled to have the same guest **twice annually**; after playing the second time as a guest, that person must become a member to continue playing with the Club. Guests are **NOT** eligible to participate in the closest to the flag prizes.

### 2. CFGC RULES

Handicap- Regardless of handicap, all members may play in any CFGC event. Handicaps greater than 36 do not qualify for tournament low net prizes.

Local Rules- CFGC may make adjustments based on local rules and course conditions on the day of play. Any adjustments to be made will be specified by the monthly coordinator.

Pace of Play- to speed up play; keep up with the group in front of you...NOT just in front of the group behind you. If there is any possibility your ball may be out of bounds or lost, hit a provisional ball. This does not apply to a water hazard.

### 3. WEEKLY EVENT

Tee Selection-A member may play any set of tees. The member's Course Handicap will be adjusted to reflect the slope of the selected Tee. Selection of desired Tee should be made when signing up for a weekly event.

CTF-Any member is eligible to win closest to the flag. Members are limited to win only once in any CTF event. If the event consists of multiple CTFs, players hitting the green with their tee shot should enter their name & distance on the proximity sheet...*even if a previous player has a closer shot...since the CTF may change as the event progresses to completion.* **If starting on a Par 3 in a shotgun event, the player is not permitted to use a mulligan to win CTF prizes.**

Weather- If weather conditions prohibit completion of a round, and less than 18 holes are played, adjustments will be made to scores for posting purposes.

**4. TOURNAMENT PLAY**- Tournaments will have an entry fee. Only those paying the entry fee will be eligible for any prizes including the CTF. Members wishing to play golf on an event day, but who choose not to pay the entry fee are welcome to do so, but will follow the field and not be eligible for prizes. The annual Holiday Event will be considered a tournament. Club rules do not apply in tournaments.

In lieu of attempting to manage and/or fund tournament event costs through the members' annual dues, the Board may establish an Event Surcharge to be announced when the event venue is announced. Anyone wishing to participate in the event and/or any of its related activities (golf/lunch/prizes) shall pay the established surcharge at the time of the event.

This will ensure that only those members participating in the event will pay the costs necessary to cover those expenses and not the entire membership. The Board will also have the ability (depending on the financial viability of the CFGC treasury) to subsidize any portion of an Event expense(s) it may deem appropriate and fiscally responsible.
