

# Bunny in a pot Crochet Pattern

## **Supplies:**

- Worsted weight yarn in brown or black for the inside of the pot
- White or another color for the bunny
- Pink felt for the inner ears and feet
- Yarn needle for sewing
- Poly-fil
- Pot- for this pattern I used a 2.5 inch opening but you can use other sizes there are instructions for that too!
- Hook size D or smaller

## **Abbreviations:**

MC- magic circle

Sc- Single crochet

Hdc- Half Double crochet

Inc- Increase

Dec- decrease

BLO- Back loops only

FOLT- Fasten off leave tail for sewing

## **DIRT**

With brown or black

R1: Sc 8 into MC (8)

R2: Inc in each stitch around (16)

R3: \*Sc, Inc\* repeat around (24)

R4: \*Sc 3, Inc\* repeat around (30)

\*At this point your circle should be almost 2.5 inches in diameter.

FOR LARGER POTS: Continue increasing by 6 stitches until you get to the desired diameter.

R5: BLO Hdc in each stitch around (30)

R6-8: working in both loops again Hdc in each stitch around (30 sts for 3 rounds) Dirt should be about ½ inches away from the top of the pot. \* Adjust if needed\*

FOR LARGER POTS: Continue crocheting hdc until your dirt is about ½ to 1 inch from the top of the pot.

R9: \*Sc 3, Dec\* repeat around (24)

R10: \*Sc 2, Dec\* repeat around (18) **add stuffing firm but not overly stuffed.**

R11: \*Sc, Dec\* repeat around (12)

R12: Dec around (6)

FOR LARGER POTS: Decrease your rounds by 6 stitches each round until you get to the end.

### **Bunny Bottom**

R1: Sc 6 into MC (6)

R2: Inc in each stitch around (12)

R3: \*Sc, Inc\* repeat around (18)

R4: \*Sc 4, Inc, Sc 4\* repeat twice (20)

R5-6: Sc in each stitch around (20 sts for 2 rounds)

R7: Sc 5, Hdc 10, Sc 5 FOLT

\*Hdc stitches will be sewn towards one side of the pot to give the bunny the right angle.

## **Feet**

Make two

R1: Sc 4 into MC (4)

R2: \*Inc, Sc\* repeat around (6)

R3-6: Sc in each stitch (6 sts for 4 rounds) FOLT

\*Cut out 6 small circles and 2 ovals for the toe beans and glue on to feet. The 4sc beginning is the tip of the toes.

## **Tail**

R1: Sc 6 into MC (6)

R2: \*Sc, Dec\* repeat around (4) FOLT

## **Ears**

Make 2

Make two

R1: Sc 4 into MC (4)

R2: \*Inc, Sc\* repeat around (6)

R3-8: Sc in each stitch (6 sts for 6 rounds) FOLT

\*cut to oblong ovals out of pink felt and glue to the ear for the inner ears.

## **Assembly**

Pin all parts into place before sewing!

Add a small amount of poly-fil to the body of the bunny, do not over stuff. Pin to dirt with the hdc stitches near the closest edge of the pot. Pin feet so that they dangle over the edge of the pot giving the bunny a stuck look. Pin tail to top of the bunny's bottom. Sew all these in place before the ears are added.

Add ears to the other edge of the pot opposite the body and sew into place. Bend the tips of the ears a bit to give it a slight curve.

With that your little bunny in a pot is all done!
