

Fire Flower

Supplies:

Hook size D

Yarn in White(**W**), Yellow(**Y**), Orange/Red (**O/R**) Green(**G**)
and Black (for eyes only)

Yarn needle

Terms used

MC- Magic Circle

Ch- Chain

Slst- Slip Stitch

Sc- Single Crochet

Hdc- Half double crochet

Dc- Double Crochet

Inc- Increase

Dec- Decrease

BLO- Back loops only

FO- Fasten off

LT- Leave tail for sewing

Flower make 2

R1: **W:** Ch 5 sc 3, 3 in last, sc 2, inc (10)

R2: Inc, sc 2, inc, sc, inc, sc2, inc, sc, (14) slst to beginning FO

R3: **Y:** attach yellow in 1st stitch of last round, Inc x2, sc 3, Inc x4, sc 3, Inc x2 (22) slst to beginning FO

R4: **R/O:** *using red or orange attach in 1st stitch of previous round sc in same, sc 9, Inc, sc 10, Inc in last (24) slst to beginning FO LT

Stem

R1: **G:** Sc 6 into MC

R2-12: 6 sc around for 11 rounds, (Stuff here if desired) fold sc 3 across top to close. FO LT

Leaves make 2

G: Ch 6, 2 dc in 1st, dc & hdc in next, hdc, sc, slst, ch1 (working on back of chain) slst in same, sc, hdc, hdc & dc, dc x2, ch 1 slst in same. FOLT

***Soil can be made using ball or square pattern if desired**

Assembly

Using Black yarn embroider on the eyes to both faces. Place the wrong sides of faces together and sew together til you get to the middle 3 stitches at the bottom of the flower.

Place the flatter end of the stem into this area and sew through the front face, stem and back face for the next 3 stitches, Finish sewing around the flower. Hide tails.

Sew leaves on opposite sides of the stem 3-4 rows above the bottom of the stem. With that you are done with your flower and it is ready to be planted anywhere!
